

Selection Process

Attendants to the Homecoming Court shall be chosen from each class by their respective class. Each person will be given a list of girls for their class from which to select the attendants. Each person will choose two girls. The four girls from each class who have the most votes and who meet the guidelines listed below will be attendants to the court.

Each female attendant may choose an escort from her respective class and he must meet the same guidelines as the female attendants.

Eligibility Requirements

Junior Class Attendants:

- Attendants must have passed at least 13 credit hours, thus obtaining junior class status
- Attendants must have been in residency at East Burke High School the previous three (3) semesters
- Attendants must have a minimum 2.0 GPA, unweighted
- Attendants can have no course failures or credit losses due to the attendance policy
- Attendants must have no out of school suspensions (OSS) violations during the previous three (3) semesters at East Burke High School
- Attendants must have had no more than two (2) office referrals resulting in in-school suspensions (ISS) during the previous three (3) semesters at EBHS. This includes referrals for tardies.
- Attendants must have no felony or misdemeanor criminal convictions.

Sophomore Class Attendants:

- Attendants must have passed at least 6 credit hours, thus obtaining sophomore class status
- Attendants must have been in residency at East Burke High School the previous semester
- Attendants must have a minimum 2.0 GPA, unweighted
- Attendants can have no course failures or credit losses due to the attendance policy
- Attendants must have no out of school suspensions (OSS) violations during the previous semester at East Burke High School
- Attendants must have had no more than one (2) office referrals resulting in in-school suspensions (ISS) during the previous semester at EBHS. This includes referrals for tardies.
- Attendants must have no felony or misdemeanor criminal convictions.

Freshman Class Attendants:

- Attendants must have a minimum 2.0 GPA, unweighted
- Attendants must have no out of school suspensions (OSS) violations during the eighth grade year of middle school
- Attendants must have had no more than two (2) office referrals resulting in in-school suspensions (ISS) during the eighth grade year of middle school.
- Attendants must have no felony or misdemeanor criminal convictions.
